Curiosity Academy STEM for Girls

Curiosity Academy is an afterschool club for girls interested in learning about science and technology. The girls will have the opportunity to start their own science project, just like real scientists! They will work in groups as companies developing a new product. They will learn about several different roles in the process including learning about the chemicals used;

making, testing, and reformulating the product; and marketing the product. The goal of the project is to demonstrate how science applies in several career paths and to show what working in a science field is actually like. Girls will be working with faculty, staff, and students from Kettering University, The University of Michigan-Flint, and Longway Planetarium.

Dates: Begins on October 20, 2014, and will meet weekly on Mondays through June 8, 2015.

Time: 4:00-5:30pm Snack will be provided.

Grades: This program is open to girls in 7th and 8th grade

Location: Girls will meet at Longway Planetarium, The University of Michigan – Flint, and Kettering University. Participants will need to provide their own transportation to and from each meeting.

Program Fee: There is a \$150 program fee for those accepted into Curiosity Academy. This program fee is due by October 20, 2014. *Limited need-based scholarship funds are available.*
